#1 Ask God Questions

Take the time to ask God questions. We often have to retreat to advance. Benjamin Franklin once said, “The doors of wisdom are never shut.” Wisdom is always available to us when we need it; we just need to ask the right questions. When you don’t know what’s next, ask for it to be revealed to you. Before you rest your conscious mind, ask for inner cues.

Do Q & A before you lay down to rest. Ask about your projects, your opportunities, your next moves and your work. I often ask questions as I go to sleep, only to awaken in the morning with refreshing solutions. When you seek inner cues before you go to bed, you will be more mindful of the outer clues that come your way. Even if you don’t pop out of bed with the perfect solution, be patient. Illumination often happens while you are in motion, going about your day.

Illumination often occurs when you are doing something unrelated to the issue at hand. It can happen while showering, driving, listening to music or taking part in another type of activity. So stay alert and keep your ears perked. Eye-opening illumination may be closer than it appears. The key is to be prepared when the answers present themselves.

Purchase a journal for your daily Q& A sessions with God. List your life's questions and fill in the answers as you get them. Ask questions, sit quietly and write down what you hear. Clarification will come once your quandaries are clearly written.

Take Fast Action:

- 1. Take 30 minutes each day to ask God for direction and insight.**
- 2. This week, take some time and really tune in**

and get divine direction. Each night before going to bed, write a list of questions that you would like God to answer.

Then, in your morning time of solitude, review the questions, sit quietly and write down all of the answers and ideas that come to you. Often you will awake with an idea or nudge that will lead you to your solution. If not, go on about your day and stay aware and alert. The answers to your questions are sure to unfold.

3. Journalize. Write down your burning questions. What divine solutions do you need right now? Take five minutes and write them now.
